- 1. Duty to Disclose
 - I will disclose any actual or possible conflict of interest to the directors and board members.
- 2. Determining Whether a Conflict of Interest Exists

The Board President and Treasurer will decide if after disclosure of all material facts, and after any discussion with the board determines a conflict of interest. It will be discussed and voted upon. The remaining board members shall decide if a conflict of interest exists.
